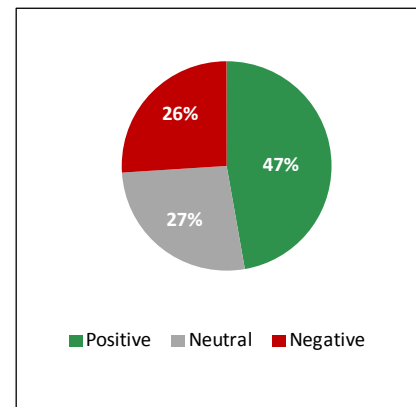
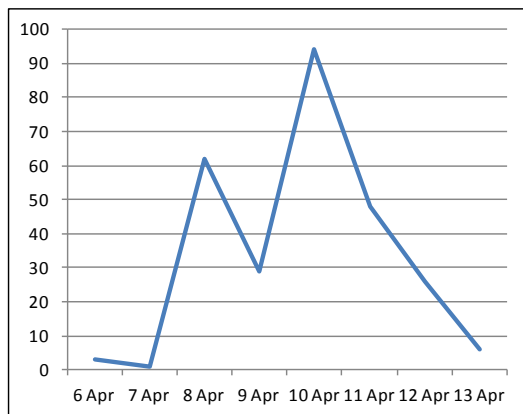

# Executive Summary

The following analysis reviews coverage relating to Statoil in the English-, French and Norwegian languages media from 06 to 13 of April 2013. The research incurred total of 269 relevant articles which averaged out at a frequency of 33.6 per day. Trade press incurred the highest volume of articles (112), while newswires generated 85 mentions. Many leading newswires, including *Reuters*, *Agence France Presse*, *Dow Jones Newswires* and *Xinhua News Agency* offered news in connection with Statoil.



There were two distinctive peaks in Statoil’s coverage. The company received a brief mention that it delayed the start of drilling in the U.S. Arctic Ocean until 2015 in articles about ConocoPhillips suspending Arctic drilling plans on 10 April. News that Greenpeace activists dressed as bears climbed aboard the Statoil-chartered rig West Hercules in the port of Olen was reported on the same day generating the highest peak for the week. Another prominent news that Statoil and Azerbaijan's state energy firm SOCAR signed a deal on exploring and developing a new offshore area in the Caspian Sea led to a peak on a smaller scale on 8 April.

The average favourability for the analysis period amounted to +0.21 (on a scale of -1 to +1), which can be considered a commendable achievement. Overall, 47% of total mentions had a positive tone mainly thanks to news about its operations in Caspian Sea, production in Skuld field and approval of its plans for the development of the Aasta Hansteen gas field and the associated Polarled pipeline by the Norwegian government. Protests by Greenpeace activists on Statoil’s rig emerged as the main negative driver.

Statoil’s CEO Helge Lund was mentioned in 29 articles over the analysed period. The vast majority of these mentions related to the signing of MoU with SOCAR to jointly explore and develop the Zafar-Mashal structures in the Azerbaijani sector of the Caspian Sea.

## 2. Greenpeace 'polar bears' protest Arctic oil drilling

Two Greenpeace activists dressed as polar bears boarded an oil platform in Norway to protest against Norwegian oil and gas group Statoil's planned drilling in the Arctic. "No oil company in the world is prepared for Arctic conditions," said the head of Greenpeace Norway, Truls Gulowsen, one of the two activists who boarded the West Hercules platform currently stationed in Oelen in southwestern Norway. "It is unacceptable that Statoil wants to gamble with safety and the environment in the vulnerable Arctic regions," he added in a statement. Greenpeace sent two "polar bears" to "inspect" the platform and to raise public awareness about the dangers of oil activities in the Arctic, a region with extreme climate conditions and located far from mainland infrastructures.

### **3. FMC Technologies Receives \$47 Million Subsea Equipment Order for Statoil's Tyrihans Field**

### **4. Statoil, SOCAR agree to develop Caspian field**

Statoil and State Oil Company of Azerbaijan (SOCAR) signed an memorandum of understanding on the joint development of the Zafar-Mashal block in Azerbaijan’s section of the Caspian Sea on 8 April. ## **7. Lundin Petroleum AB: Oil discovery in Luno II exploration well offshore Norway**

Swedish oil firm Lundin Petroleum said that it had made a potentially significant oil find off Norway, near another discovery that renewed explorers' interest in the North Sea. "A gross oil column in excess of 40 metres has been proven" at the Luno II well, the company said in a statement, adding that the oil was of good quality. Lundin has a 40 percent stake in the Luno II well, with Norway's Statoil and Britain's Premier Oil holding 30 percent each.

## 6. ConocoPhillips puts Arctic drilling plans on ice

ConocoPhillips said that it would abandon its plans to begin drilling in Arctic waters north of Alaska because of regulatory uncertainties, underscoring the oil industry's growing reservations about developing the icy, remote region. Following similar decisions by Shell and Statoil, the move amplifies questions about whether drilling in the remote, icy region is worth the financial costs and environmental risks as energy companies extract ever more crude on U.S. lands. Statoil has delayed its planned exploration until at least 2015 and threatened to abandon its U.S. Arctic leases altogether.
